

APPLICATIONS

We recommend that you apply early, if possible by 20th December of the year in which your child starts Year 4. Application forms can be found on our website or you can contact us and we can send them to you by mail or via email. Upon receipt of your application your child will be put on the list of applicants for the desired school year. All applicants will receive an invitation to take part in the entrance examination.

The examination consists of a written test that evaluates the child's German language skills and level of proficiency in Mathematics. In some circumstances, interviews are also conducted with the child and their parents. The school admission committee then sits together and decides which students receive admission to our school. The child's performance across the testing process is pivotal.

SCHOOL FEES

The Pierre Trudeau International Grammar School is a state-approved, independently operated alternative school and is therefore not fully financed by the state of Saxony-Anhalt. For this reason, it is necessary for parents to make a monthly contribution.



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HOW OUR STUDENTS TRAVEL HERE

Many of our students use the bus or train for their daily journey to school. The railway station is located right across from the school. There are trains coming from Haldensleben and Magdeburg on a daily basis during

regular school hours. Several bus routes also stop here. Travel allowances can be applied for at the relevant education authorities.

OUR EDUCATION

Our students are prepared for the central Abitur of the state of Saxony-Anhalt and thus obtain a state-recognised Abitur. We offer problem- and action-oriented teaching in state-of-the-art, specially equipped classrooms. These are supported by available digital media and interactive whiteboards in all classrooms for all students.

An important aim is to learn numerous world languages and their use in the relevant contexts. Alongside the two "first foreign languages" of French and English and other foreign language programmes, the International Grammar School is the only general school in Saxony-Anhalt where Chinese is also part of the regular educational programme up to Abitur level. In addition, it is also possible to obtain the German-French Abitur (Abi-Bac).

Our global citizen trips give our students the opportunity to use their communication skills and languages in practical situations. Over the course of the school year our students acquire international language certificates that enable them, immediately following their Abitur, to study at international universities
